Established in 1992, Pais has become an international movement on six continents.

Our Mission: We seek to spark a movement whereby one day "the primary mission of every Christian will be to advance the Kingdom of God and be equipped to do it the way Jesus modeled it."

Our Message: We share a Kingdom-centric Gospel; "to seek first the Kingdom of God, and do it God's way, in order to give God what He wants."

Structure

Here are some key elements to how Pais delivers our vision.

- We provide full-time teams of young adults to our partners.
- We provide a free mission year to young adults who come from the UK and overseas.
- We provide Masterclasses and other forms of training for churches, networks and events.
- We have three main sources of income: contributions from partners, financial supporters and grants.

History

Before the pandemic Pais in the UK was growing at a strong rate. Due to the global situation, plus a visa issue that has now been resolved, our ability to recruit team members was dramatically halted. We are now glad to say that Pais is once again rebuilding and the future is looking good.

- Covid Period: 2 nations | 7 teams | 24 members
- 2022 Projection: 3 nations | 11 teams | 40 members
- 2026 Projection: 5 nations | 20 teams | 90 members

Objectives

'The Big Three' are key elements a National Director focusses on to deliver our vision.

- Vision:** To work with your team, who are coached by Pais Global, in order to oversee the effectiveness of the Pais Teams in the UK and Ireland. This will involve inspiring, motivating, teaching and co-ordination.

Training and Support
